### REPORT for the NAU (Nordisk Arboretudvalg) meeting in Latvia and Lithuania June the 3rd to June the 7th, 2009

#### Aims, programme and outcome of NAU meeting

##### 1. Symposium: A Changing World and The Genetic Resources of Gardens, Parks and Landscapes in the Nordic Region

held at Bulduri Horticultural College, Jurmala, Bulduri, Viestura street 6, LV-2010 Latvia.

**Knud Ib Christensen:** The NAU or Nordic Arboretum Committee – a brief introduction – 10 minutes

**Frans Emil Wielgolaski:** Plants and Climate – 20 minutes

**Oddvar Skre:** Regional trends in annual growth and time of budburst in birch (*Betula pubescens*) as related to climate change – 20 minutes

**Elisabeth Öberg:** Why is it important to save the old ornamental woody plant material? – A north Swedish perspective 1980–2008 – 20 minutes

**Björn Aldén:** Long-termed work in a world of short-termed activities - The Landscape Arboretum of the Gothenburg Botanical Garden – 20 minutes

**Tomas Lagerström:** Plant Selection and Improvement from a User's Perspective – 20 minutes

The symposium was held according to the plan with six speakers. There was an audience of some 30 persons and the discussions after the lectures were lively and informative. ##### 2. Excursions to Latvian and Lithuanian arboreta, botanical gardens and nurseries relevant to the topic of the symposium

###### Latvia:

**June the 4th.** After the symposium a guided tour in the park of Bulduri College.

**June the 5th.** Guided tours in the Babite experimental station's Rhododendron collection, Lacupe Arboretum and A. Auder's private collection of conifer cultivars.

**June the 6th.** Guided tours in the city parks of Ventspils, the Ives Nursery, city parks of Liepaja, and the new Rucava Arboretum.

**Lithuania:**

**June the 7th.** Guided tour in the Botanical Garden, Klaipeda.

During the excursions the members of the NAU discussed further the topic of the symposium as well as other topics relevant to the aims of the NAU, i.e., to obtain new plant material of dendrological interest, to provide information on development of dendrological material, and to promote exchange of seed and plants between the members.

The number of participants were expected to be 20, but the actual number of NAU members attending the annual meeting were only 10 (see Appendix 1).

It is apparent from the table above that the expenses to transportation were larger than expected (approx. 1.9 times the expected amount of money) primarily due to an increase in the price of flight tickets, but on the other hand the hotel expenses were lower than expected (approx. 0.4 times the expected amount of money).

6494,15 DKK (= 1055,30 EUR) has not been used and will be returned when this report has been approved by the SNS.
